Skudai, Johor - Syarikat konsesi penyenggaraan jalan, Belati Wangsa (M) Sdn Bhd (BWSB) dan Institut Sultan Iskandar, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (ISI UTM) memetraikan memorandum persefahaman (MoU) kearah kemampuan serta kelestarian industri penyenggaraan jalan, hari ini.
